- -Which one is better, either using design effect and adding response rate or reducing the stages to select study subjects?
- -Do you believe that a study participant can represent the whole students?
- -What about social support scale score below 12?
- -better to state the reliability and validity of the tool

- -When you say that mild, moderate and severe common mental illness? It is not clear. There is inconsistency of report on moderate CMD, one says 119 the other says 61?
