The article utilizes primary, classic sociology and anthropology even history theories (Malinowski, Weber, Toynbee). Perhaps also (when time permits) attempt to trace the academic discussions that followed these early theories (secondary sources that critique and also "revitalize" them so to speak).

Include more in-text citation in some parts that are continuous sentence narratives- some may need to be anchored to relevant sources.

Consider Pela Gandong as IKSP Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Practices also. In this light the revitalization is towards the original worldview before external influences (colonization, christianization).
