There should be no expressions containing mathematical technical terms in the abstract.

The abstract is generally written to give the reader brief and concise information about the content of the article.

Therefore, the abstract should be revised. Titles should not be used when writing author names.

First of all, the study does not qualify as an academic article. There are no literature reviews in the study. Only the author's work is given in the reference section, and this method is far from being an academic article.

Language errors are also noticeable in many paragraphs, such as the confusion of "we" and "I".

There is only one citation in the study, and it is incorrectly worded.

In summary, no matter how beautiful any study is, and even if it is a study that adds value to the literature, if it is far from the language of academic writing, the work done will remain in the second place.

Therefore, the study should be written in a way to have academic language in the first place; the summary, introduction, reference, etc., parts should be written properly.

I am sure that this study will be very useful and meaningful if it is revised in a way that can be applied in many fields, revised in a way that will really benefit the literature, and if the corrections I mentioned above are made.

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
