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The article is quite interesting and raise a very serious issue. However, It requires serious in-depth investigation and the claims should be supported by empirical evidences.

The author should elaborate the methodology. It has not describe the sample size, study area etc.

There might be sampling error. The claims are made from the Indian case and many not be universally accepted norm.

There are many international research programmes that are executed through research consortia approach. The scientists involved in Mega-Science Project for example CERN research project etc. where cross country collaboration involving many scientists is a basic norm. As a result, increase in the collaborative research papers is obvious.

Finally, the article lacks academic rigors and the claims are not backed up with data. It requires major rework to make it a research article.
