

Review of: "[Case Report] A Rare Case of Carcinoma Erysipeloides After TNBC Mastectomy: Challenges in Diagnosis and Implications for Treatment"

1. The patient was mentioned to be 43 years old and 44 years old at different sites of the manuscript.
2. The initial breast carcinoma radiology and pathology images are not provided. It is not clear if the patient was managed surgically or how the initial diagnosis of TNBC was confirmed. Please provide the radiology, biopsy, and IHC pathological images to confirm the initial diagnosis of TNBC.
3. The site of the current skin lesions is not clearly stated in the text.
4. The histopathology images are of poor quality.
5. No IHC was done to confirm the breast origin of the current CE lesions. As regards the TNBC, GATA3 or other breast origin markers may be beneficial to confirm the breast origin.
6. The discussion of different origins of this condition and its differential diagnosis needs much elaboration.
