

Review of: "Comparison of Vegetation Community Diversity, Biomass, and Sediment Properties among Constructed and Reference Salt Marshes at Deer Island, Mississippi, U.S.A."

I think this is a relatively standardized academic paper with clear logic and interesting results. My biggest question, however, is why there were so few sampling parameters in 2019 fall. This sampling season was also barely mentioned in the results and discussion sections. I think the authors need to explain this problem in the section of materials and methods.

Some specific suggestions are as follows:

1. There are many acronyms in the paper. It is suggested to add a list of acronyms.
2. The innovative contribution needs to be emphasized in the introduction.
3. Table 2 is proposed as a three-line table.
4. The names of charts and tables are very long, and it is suggested to reduce the characters. What needs to be explained is given in the form of notes.

Overall, I think this is a work worth publishing.
