- · No conclusion is provided in the abstract
- No aim and/or objectives in mentioned at the end of introduction
- Section 2.2: The method is not clear what is meant by "weighed quantity of 50 mg/ml of each species was taken, and 50 g of powder of each species"
- · Species names must be italics
- Exact concentration of extracts and the bacterial strength added to the well is not mentioned clearly. Precisely, 400 uL
 of ?? concentration?
- · Check the SI units for hours as h, etc.,
- Is the anti-bacterial activity is performed in triplicate? if so where the deviation values of ZOI?
- Section 3.4: it is not all clear to read and understand the graph. Revise it.
- Why the authors didn't performed MIC values determination, please justify.
