By examining specialized literature, the authors underscore the opportunities presented by the groundbreaking advancement of digital platforms in enhancing student learning and fostering communication between students and teachers. They also address the challenges linked to the use of digital platforms and their effective implementation. The methodology is well-defined. However, the findings regarding the use of MOOCs and LMSs are somewhat generic and lack detailed insights. The authors could enhance their work by including data from their literature review on the number of higher educational institutions offering MOOCs and LMS services to their students.
