This manuscript was found worthy. It was well written and is appropriate for publication, but some minor revisions, given below, should be done.

1. Page 3, lines 4 and 6: What do the authors mean by "thin slices"? What is the thickness of a slice?
2. Page 3, section 2.1.2, preparation of extracts: Were the extracts diluted to a final volume after centrifugation and filtration? For the calculation of bioactive compounds in extracts, the dilution ratio is important. What is the dilution ratio?
3. Page 3, section 2.1.4: At the end of the paragraph, the authors reported that TFC was expressed as mg CE/100g. What is CE? CE probably means catechin equivalent, but it should be written in the method section in the text.
4. Page 4, section 2.1.5.2: What is the control sample?

The unit "ml" should be changed to "mL" in the whole text.
