Here are some comments:

1. In the introduction, you should state which molecules contribute to the therapeutic properties, i.e., antioxidation.
2. The Latin name of ginger should be in italics.
3. At the end of chapter 2.1.3., is a parenthesis?
4. When abbreviations for a word are mentioned for the first time in the text, their full names should be given (e.g., GAE, CE, DPPH).
5. Standardize the writing for the word antioxidant because somewhere in the text it says anti-oxidant.
6. List more references for comparison in the chapters on phenols and antioxidation.
7. In supplementary data 3, only some numbers have letters next to them; what about others? If the results have been statistically processed, it should be mentioned.
