Here are some comments:

- 1. In the introduction, you should state which molecules contribute to the therapeutic properties, i.e., antioxidation.
- 2. The Latin name of ginger should be in italics.
- 3. At the end of chapter 2.1.3., is a parenthesis?
- 4. When abbreviations for a word are mentioned for the first time in the text, their full names should be given (e.g., GAE, CE, DPPH).
- 5. Standardize the writing for the word antioxidant because somewhere in the text it says anti-oxidant.
- 6. List more references for comparison in the chapters on phenols and antioxidation.
- 7. In supplementary data 3, only some numbers have letters next to them; what about others? If the results have been statistically processed, it should be mentioned.

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
