- 4. Some entries in the bibliography are incomplete, e.g., Yembi 2000.
- 5. Confirm the spelling of the names of some genera, e.g., Pterocarpus on page 5.
- 6. Some figures have captions in French these should be translated to English.
- 7. The grammar in the article needs to be improved, preferably by a first language English speaker.
