The Authors should restrict descriptions of VC to the introduction part. The first paragraph is not essential.

Institutional Ethical Committee permission for this study is mandatory. Written informed consent is also a compulsory item in such a study.

The statement "I was provided access to patient records" is meaningless in a manuscript with more than one author.

There are no inclusion criteria or exclusion criteria for the selection of patients.

The sensitivity of microscopical examination for the diagnosis of candida in a vaginal smear is usually only 60%, thus it should be combined at least with a culture examination for screening of patients for VC.

Statistical analysis following the null hypothesis is essential.

The Authors should resubmit the manuscript following these suggestions.
