Abstract: it is well written but doesn't include data about the patient and the method used for treatment (needs to be more informative).

Also, anosmia is written as "anomia" in this sentence (There is an increased prevalence of anomia/parosmia in patients that have clinically) in both abstract and introduction and in discussion(reported a complete resolution of anomia 24 hours after the second SGB.).

in Clinical vignette: it would be mor beneficial if there are some data about the technique used for injection, the precautions taken before block and if there are any investigations needed. Also, possible adverse effects and the follow up after ganglion block.
