There is lack of clarity and coherence in conveying its central ideas. The concepts and arguments are not effectively organized, and the article lacks a clear and concise thesis statement or central focus.

The article doesn't include alternative viewpoints or engage with a wider range of perspectives, such as those from other religious traditions or viewpoints.
