Dr. Leong has written a compelling essay that works from the metaphysical foundations of Daoism and quantum physics. I like the way he weaves the narratives together. But I must also add that I found this paper utterly exasperating! His sources are not fully referenced in the text (just an author name and date), and he hops from one to another at breakneck speed, only to go back abruptly to the one he started with. The second version is better than the first, but it is still something of an ordeal by labyrinth. If Daoism and the I Ching were not close to my heart, I would have chucked in the sponge.
