Furthermore, the abstract could benefit from elucidating the limitations of the reviewed literature and suggesting avenues for future research. Overall, this review offers valuable insights into the multifaceted roles of grandparents in supporting children with special needs, but further elaboration on its implications and areas for future inquiry would enhance its scholarly impact.

Essentially, the study makes a noteworthy contribution to the body of knowledge, though it does need minor revisions.
