- 3. The objective of this study was not stated clearly. This will help in discussion of findings and recommendations.
- 4. There is no theory guiding this study. Theory provides ideological illumination to research.
- 5. There is no recommendations made from this study.
- 6. What is the contribution to knowledge. I recommend acceptance after minor corrections.

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
