# Review of: "Sociodemographic, Clinical, and Psychological Barriers to Medication Compliance: The Case of Patients with Musculoskeletal Disorders in Greece"

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The authors present a well-written cross-sectional study to examine barriers to medication compliance among patients with musculoskeletal disorders in Greece. The introduction should be revised to provide relevant background and rationale in a more concise manner. Further information is required in the methods section, such as how the sample size was derived and how data were collected. A standard reporting guideline (such as the STROBE checklist) should be used.
