- 1. The paper's content is imbalanced. According to the title, the major part is supposed to be the sections 'Phytomorphic and Zoomorphic Representations' and 'Connections between two parks'. However, the authors have used almost half of the paper for some general information.
- 2. The entire paper seems more like an introduction than research, mainly consisting of descriptions but not detailed analyses or profound discussions.
- 3. Strictly, the similarity between phytomorphic/zoomorphic motifs and real plants/animals is untestable because most of the motifs are in linear style, i.e., quite abstract; thus, their connection with actual plants and animals is not logically exclusive. For example, we cannot deny a possibility that they could also be works of hallucination.

The paper will have more scientific significance if the authors can solve the problems mentioned above.
