I went through the article, and I will try to convey some suggestions to the authors. For more consistency in the research, a mention would be useful to explain why ROA, ROE, Profit Margin, and Net Interest Margin are considered the most relevant indicators for measuring bank performance. Similarly, it would be useful for indicators related to the evaluation of intellectual capital.

An explanation for the representativeness at the level of Asia for the countries included in the sample would be welcome. The formulation of the hypotheses might be more suitable to be included in the "Data Methodology" section. The statistical processing is well done. In order to make even better use of the research results, I would encourage the authors to make a comparison of the research results with those of other studies carried out in the field.

I hope that the suggestions made will be useful to the authors in order to substantiate the research results and increase the visibility of the article.
