Although it is a valuable study in terms of the parameters and findings evaluated, I believe that some aspects need to be improved:

- 1. It would be appropriate to change the statement "...that makes gonioscopy and cataract difficult" to "...that makes gonioscopy and cataract surgery difficult" in the sentence at the end of the study design section.
- 2. Even though it is a relatively new technique, the number of patients could have been higher.
- 3. The effect of the implant could be more clearly demonstrated by comparing the "trabecular micro-bypass stent implant combined with phacoemulsification" group with the group that undergone only phacoemulsification.
