It would be more persuasive and informative by giving more specific examples and references, rather than giving a general assessment.
- 3. From paper writing perspective, it's generally organized, but pay attention to grammar and citation norms. For example, I can see both "(French and RioosInsua, 2000)" and "(Jungwon Park & Keon-Hyung Lee, 2020)", which is not consistent.

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
