

Review of: "Curriculum Implementation with a Plan: An Exploratory Analysis of Pre-service Teachers' Application of Gagne's Nine Events of Instruction"

The article is quite interesting, and it has succeeded in describing the current situation in Ghana, which has some similarities with Indonesia. However, I do have several things to point out:

1. The author has not described/explained the methodology section quite thoroughly, especially the method of data collection. After mentioning the subjects and samples, she goes straight to data analysis. A paragraph explaining the data collection procedures would make the article much better.
2. In the findings section, the author mentioned several times that the pre-service teachers disagreed on some points; it would be much clearer if the percentages of disagreements were elaborated.
3. There is an inconsistency on the Likert scale mentioned; at the beginning, it is mentioned that a 4-scale questionnaire was used, but in the section "Pre-service Teachers' Application of Gagne Instructional Plan," it is mentioned that a five-point Likert scale was used.
