The introduction would improve if it included: the motivation and relevance of the topic, objectives of the study, main conclusions and contributions and if it presented the structure of the paper. The structure of the paper seems a bit confusing to me, with multiple titles and subtitles.

Suggestions for future research (future work) could be included at the end of the conclusions.

The topic of limitations may be confused with the limitations in the development of the study. In this sense, it would change the title or add it to another topic.
