Addiction Ontology

**Definition:** A commodity that is formed from parts of the tobacco plant.

Informal definition: Anything that is made from the tobacco plant or parts of it.

**Comment:** The parent class is 'commodity' to highlight the most common usage of the term in tobacco research which focuses on tobacco products that are manufactured and sold.

This definition was imported from the Addiction Ontology (see <a href="https://addictovocab.org/">https://addictovocab.org/</a>). Comments and suggestions for improvements are welcome using the Qeios review system.

Ontological definitions can sometimes be hard to read. In those cases we also include an informal definition.

Definitions also often require elaboration to make it clear how they should be used and what they include. In those cases we include a comment.

Also, definitions sometimes require an explanation as to how they came about to help users understand how they relate to alternative definitions. In those cases we include a curator note.
