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The paper titled "A fintech clustering framework: Technology, Model and stakeholder perspectives" is a well-formulated piece of research. The decision to adopt a narrative review is well justified. The inclusion of both academic literature and industry sources is a significant strength. However, the following points can be considered to improve the quality of the research paper:

- 1) It would be helpful to readers if the strategy to select the first initial 25 studies is clarified.
- 2) The study has inferences drawn both from academics and practitioners; the author can give an outline as to how these sources were merged into the narrative.
