# **Review of: "Minor Foreign Bodies Remaining in the Stratum Corneum of the Plantar Skin Are Mistaken for Plantar Fasciitis: A Case Report (Mechanism of Injury Analysis and Literature Review)"**

## **Strengths**

The case presents a common injury, which in this case was overlooked and caused long-term persistent symptoms.

The discussion emphasizes differences between foreign body retention and plantar fasciitis.

The article provides a simple, effective technique for foreign body removal.

## **Weaknesses**

The article describes a single case, which does not represent long-term statistical experience. Due to the lack of previous data, the discussion is limited in terms of possible complications and further differential diagnosis.
