I feel the abstract and introduction can be a bit more elaborate and include the purpose of this work, so as to attract recent researchers. The conclusion as a separate paragraph may add value to the article.

Under heading 3, it is given as "formulae by B.K. Choudury before Eq 8". Please give the equation number for ease of understanding and add contents too before Eq. 8

More clarity on the origin of Eq 7 would be better. As per the current explanation, only an expert in the domain may be able to understand.

Eq 8, 9, 10, please mention from which equation these three terms are taken.

A bit more clarity at the end of the paper regarding the purpose would be better.

If by any chance there is a provision for validation of the results, it might add value to the paper.
