It is a very interesting topic for review. However, there are some major points you could consider to enhance your writing.

## Introduction

The writing of the introduction should be improved and made more readable to the English reader. There are several grammatical errors and typos you could consider. Try to merge the Background & Theoretical Foundations heading with the introduction heading, and try to shorten the introduction section by omitting detailed and unnecessary information and data.

## Methods

Try to avoid using quotations all over the article like: "When a researcher intends to examine the validity of a theory, a model, or a hypotheses, s/he uses the comparative content analysis method"(Momenirad et al). Try rephrasing the sentences instead.

What are the four dimensions of women's identity?

The methods section is poorly written and unclear to understand.

The authors jumped from the methods section into components extracted, and then mentioned the conclusions. Try to write the main findings of the study in the results section, followed by a discussion section discussing the main findings of the study and comparing them with those of previous studies.

## Conclusion

Try to summarize the findings of the study in the conclusion section. In another paragraph, you could mention the future implications of this study for researchers or policymakers.
