**Methodology Elaboration:** The methodology discussion lacks detail regarding data collection, variable operationalization, and the rationale for choosing the ordered logistic regression model. Providing this information is essential for readers to understand the study's foundation.

**Grammar and Spelling:** Several grammatical errors and typos are present throughout the article. A thorough proofreading process is essential to enhance the overall writing quality.



**Citation and Reference Consistency:** Some references cited in the review section are missing from the reference list, indicating a need for meticulous cross-checking to maintain academic integrity.

**Enhance Methodology Discussion:** Provide a comprehensive overview of the methodology, including data collection procedures, variable definitions, and rationale for the chosen analysis methods.

**Proofreading and Editing:** Conduct a meticulous proofreading and editing process to eliminate grammatical errors, typos, and inconsistencies in language usage.

**Review Citations and References:** Ensure all cited references are accurately listed in the reference section and conform to the required citation style.
