The article compares Sweden's and India's approaches to climate change and sustainability. This is an intriguing topic given that one of the countries is a wealthy nation with a mature economy, while the other is a rapidly emerging one with distinct priorities, but both experiencing the effects of climate change.

Although there is an attempt to list of all the strategies adopted by each nation, this study lacks any novelty or methodological approach; for example, explaining how the comparison criteria were selected should be emphasized more. Using indicators that support the comparison in a more objective manner could have been considered. The whole content is quite generic, it is a good starting point but, in my opinion, it should be adjusted to fit into an academic article.
