Please find my comments below:

1. The Introduction section did not include a recent literature survey on this topic. In addition, the authors need to provide more information on the characteristics of the women's workforce and their socio-economic conditions in the region.
2. The authors need to briefly highlight the study area, i.e., BTR.
3. The methodology section lacks details regarding the sample size considered in the study. The author should add a flowchart indicating the applied sampling method, sample size selection, and the method to examine the objectives.
4. The Results section is not well presented. The authors' findings should be supported through graphs, charts, and suitable statistical methods.
5. Brief limitations of this study should also be discussed by the author.
6. There are many grammatical errors and typographical errors in this work. The author should correct these errors before the final publication of the work.
7. In addition, the study should highlight how it will benefit international readers.
