

# Review of: "Impact of risk factor diabetes mellitus on patients with periodontitis"

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Appreciation for authors who have compiled a kind of literature review. Some of the main things that can be noted are, firstly, the title used is like referring to a condition of diabetes mellitus that puts the patient at risk for periodontitis. However, in the description in the manuscript, it is revealed that there is a bi-direct relationship between diabetes and periodontitis, where diabetes can affect periodontitis, and on the contrary, it is stated that periodontitis can affect diabetes. The author seems to have missed the description of the exact purpose of this paper. In the introduction, it has not condensed what the purpose is, although in the abstract it is slightly mentioned. In my opinion, if the author wants to reveal the prevention method and the method of treating periodontal patients with a diagnosis of diabetes, this can indeed be a kind of bi-direction. In a sense, the direction is how to prevent a diabetic from developing periodontitis and how to prevent a periodontitis person from developing diabetes. To prove this bi-direction condition, it is necessary to support the results of longitudinal studies, which are stronger than cross-sectional studies, especially for the direction of periodontitis to diabetes. If indeed the direction is bi-direct, then the title should be changed to the reciprocal relationship as well. However, if the direction only wants to show how the risk or opportunity for a diabetic to experience periodontitis and how to prevent it, then, in my opinion, this can be called one way, with the title being appropriate but in the description, the discussion must focus on this one direction. This is the most important in my opinion.
