The topic of the article is very interesting because it discusses the important dilemma between promoting geosites and growth of tourists/visitors, as well as related destroying of such sites. This is a serious problem that affects all attractive tourist areas and facilities.

However, the text needs improvement. It lacks the presentation of the location of the caves (a map) and description of caves, along with literature items.

Moreover, in the methodological scope - the number of samples (interviews) is small and therefore not representative, although it is important for the first conclusions and possible further research. The text is missing a broader, synthetic description of the content of the interviews. Perhaps a solution for broader research would be a survey with an open list of answer options.

The conclusions and possible scenarious of mitigation negative tourism impact should be wider. described.
