This is a short and concise case comparative article. The author's ideas are clear, and the two cases provide a simple and clear explanation of the macro strategies and micro measures taken by different countries (Sweden and India) to address climate change. The content written is in line with the actual situation and has a certain enlightening effect on other countries. The author has also read a certain amount of literature and the writing is relatively standardized.

However, it should be noted that firstly, the article lacks comparison between the different development backgrounds of two countries, thus limiting the reference value of relevant conclusions. Secondly, such short case comparative articles need to be adapted to the publication requirements of specific journals, and it is unknown whether these types of articles are suitable for your journal's style.

In short, this article has certain reference value, but it is not a deep original research paper and may not be suitable for academic research journals. Of course, it is also possible to publish this article as a short case study.
