

# Review of: "Side effects of COVID-19 vaccination in Pakistani population: A cross sectional study"

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The article is well prepared and should be published soon - as one of the following pieces of evidence about vaccine effectiveness and safety of COVID-19 vaccines. It consists of lots of tables and graphs.

1. It is hard to find how to check patients' "COVID-19" status - by checking PCR/ antigen tests or measuring antibody levels.
2. The article needs some language correct - some phrases are hard to understand, and it is easy to find a few **colloquial** verbs like "heart attack".
3. As mentioned earlier, there is a lack of more severe side effects - autoimmune disorders, myocarditis or acute demyelinating polyneuropathy. It is necessary to add this information and, if possible, compare them with severe complications of COVID-19.
