The manuscript refers to a technical report concerning "a novel anti-gravitational thread pathway technique to promote face lift".

Before considering it for publishing, it is important to highlight some issues found during review:

**ABSTRACT:** the limitations described in abstract should appear in main text, where author quietly inserted study's limitations suggesting future studies in CONCLUSION section.

**TECHNICAL REPORT:** figure 1 - red and dark dots must have been described in figure's legend and not only in text as presented. All figures should be self explanatory.

**CONCLUSION:** as previously described in this report, all limitations should be presented to avoid readers' conclusions inconsistencies. Author refer to the need for future studies, but what kind of future studies author suggest? How does the author consider this a relevant manuscript as the basis for future clinical decisions?

In my opinion, manuscript can be suitable for publishing after a minor revision.
