The article is interesting, informative, and ambitious. An attempt to compare Serbian Orthodox beliefs relating to death with those in Buddhist traditions may potentially be thought-provoking and enlightening. However, the uncritical use of a 'translated' Buddhist text that may in fact be of questionable theosophist origins is of concern. Adding a Jungian perspective to belief systems relating to death also certainly has merit. However, the author might consider narrowing her focus to specific aspects and making use of a more precisely defined methodology.
