1- The very good topic has been considered by the author of the article, but it needs to be enriched from a methodological point of view. It is recommended that a section entitled "Methodology" be added to the article and it should be explained exactly from which source the data was selected and how it was analyzed. Currently, good examples of Grammatical Aspects of Feminatives from the Ukrainian language are mentioned in the article and the problems they have created are also stated. But it is not clear how these bugs were extracted? Are these errors frequent in Ukrainian grammar? They can be considered as errors only if they have a significant frequency in the text;

2- Research literature also needs enrichment. It is necessary to deal with the works that have been done in this field in more detail. Also, it may be appropriate to refer to the works that have dealt with feminist approaches in other languages (for example: Revealing gender discourses in the Qur'ān);

3- Although the title of the article is dedicated to Aspects of Grammatical Feminatives, but practically, among the Aspects, it only addressed the problems created by this approach and did not say anything about its advantages. Therefore, if it is not going to be said about the advantages of Grammatical Feminatives, the title should also be changed and instead of Aspects, a word that shows the problems and disadvantages will be used. But if this title is to be kept, a section should be dedicated to the benefits.
