In this study, the authors presented a 23-year-old male patient who showed gingival hyperplasia for 6 years and had a history of taking corticosteroids for a year.

The study is well-written. However, it has some drawbacks which are specified as follows:

1. Please provide a more thorough past drug and medical history. Has the consumption of other drugs known to cause gingival hypertrophy been ruled out?
2. Have diseases causing gingival hypertrophy, such as leukemia and granulomatosis diseases, been well examined and assessed?
3. What was the timing of corticosteroid consumption, and what was the interval between that consumption and the starting of gingival hypertrophy?
4. It would be better if the authors stuck to one term throughout the text, as "gingival overgrowth" and "gingival enlargement" have both been used.
