It is an interesting work, dealing with a relevant subject. Although providing good insights in this version manuscript, I suggest the author the evaluation of the following improvements:

- 1. Sections 2 and 3 could be merged in one. Section 2 does not seem to be a part of the context of the manuscript as it is in this version of the manuscript.
- 2. A clear definition of business project is missed in section 3. In fact, the focus is on the presentation of the aspects related to construction projects. I suggest the addition of a table describing the differences found between business and construction projects considering the various aspects mentioned in section 3.
- 3. Section 5 is straightforward written, lacking an introduction of the mentioned techniques. I suggest the author to consider the addition of a brief description of each of these techniques in the new version of the manuscript. I guess that this improvement would turn the paper more readable, specially looking to the potential readers that are not so familiarized with these concepts.
- 4. I encourage the use of more comparison tables in the manuscript to provide a better and more effective visualization and understanding of the content of the article.

I hope these comments could provide some insights to the author, contributing to the increase of the number of future readers of the article.
