This well written article explores the relationship between the academic succee of high ability, high IQ senior high school students and 4 psychological factors - Attachment, Emotional intelligence, Self-efficacy, and parental involvement. Each one of these 4 factors contribute independently to a high IQ student's success. Of the 4, Emotional intelligence contributes the most, but each independently add.

The integration of previous literature and the discussion is excellent. The article adds to the growing literature showing how social stressors impact academic performance by noting that positive attributes can make academic success more likely.
