This perspective article is about an interesting and important topic. I like the preface and the historical aspects. The text is clear and well-written, the authors' point of view is justified with numerous examples. The article mainly focuses on antibody-mediated (and vaccine-induced) immune responses. I agree with the authors that the term "sin" can be misleading.

What I missed is at least one paragraph about role of OAS in cellular immune response. A schematic explanatory figure could help non-immunologist to understand the term and the phenomenon easier.

In sum, I think the article is concise, straightforward and worth-to-read.
