The study is interesting. However there are a few points to be considered

- 1. The authors do not mention ethical issues. Did they administer to the patients and informed consent? Did they receive an ethical approval?
- 2. Is the questionnaire validated? Is it tested for understanding?
- 3. To my opinion the authors should make a distinction between the answers given by the pediatric age group, adult age and eldery people. In this way they can properly recommend interventions to be made according to differences in age groups.
- 4. It would be interesting to have 4-5 specific reccomendations concluded from the results of this study
- 5. A more advanced statistical analysis can be made to see relationships between variables and make an analysis of these connections
