

# Review of: "Challenge in Old People Care in Nursing Homes during COVID-19 Pandemia: Role of Nurses"

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The topic that the article deals with is a very interesting topic. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the role of nurses in nursing homes has been of vital importance to guarantee the health and well-being of residents. Roles or responsibilities such as Epidemiologic Surveillance or Education and Training have not been mentioned: Nurses are also responsible for providing education and training to residents, staff, and families on topics related to COVID-19.

Add that although the title talks about nurses, in the development it is not clear if it is referring exclusively to these professionals and mixes the care provided to residents with dementia with those who do not suffer from it. Perhaps because of the general nature of the article.

It is important to note that the role of nurses can vary depending on geographic location, specific health policies, and the needs of the nursing home.
