The authors have compiled the study to consolidate existing knowledge and provide a comprehensive overview. But in my opinion, revisions are necessary to increase the depth of the text and the clarity of the facts. It is recommended to give antibiograms for gram-positive microorganisms. The entire article should be reviewed; the cases, and especially the discussion section, should be deepened, and the necessary inferences should be stated.
