

## Review of: "Covid-19 vaccine prevalence and its associated factors among rural households in The Gambia: a community-based cross-sectional study"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

The sampling strategy and sample size are clearly stated.

More information is required on:

- 1. Instrument development.
- 2. Uptake of the Covid-19 vaccine: how it was measured, like self-report, record review, or both.
- 3. Abstract results are presented in Odds Ratio (Males are 2.7 times more likely). The discussion section, paragraph 2, is presented as a proportion (high prevalence in females 29%). It is confusing.

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
