I have gone through the manuscript and following are my suggestions to improve it further. Generally, the structure of the whole manuscript needs a revisit as it does not strictly comply with the standard format of a review article e.g., Abstract is very brief and does not look like having any structure such as the background, hypothesis, results of different scientific studies, and conclusion. Initially, the authors have mentioned about the sugar cane syrup, coconut water and grapes as alternative way of treatment but didn't discuss it in their article. The review mostly discusses the Metformin and Ezetimibe, which is not exactly the title speaks for. In conclusion, I shall not recommend it for publication until completely modified. The authors should also focus on the language.
