The paper does not seem to possess the qualities of a well-structured, robust research paper and needs substantial changes on the following bases:

- 1. A more comprehensive abstract and introduction is needed.
- 2. The review of the literature section is too brief. Reference to previous studies is a requirement for a sound research paper. The gap in the literature and the purpose of the study have not been elaborated adequately.
- 3. Information about the methodology is inadequate. A more detailed description of the research participants, research instrument(s), data collection and analysis procedures is demanded. Particularly, the instrument section seems not to include a description of the instrument employed but an insertion of the survey items into this section.
- 4. The findings need to be visualized via tabulation, using charts, or other techniques to facilitate their comprehensibility.
- 5. The discussion and conclusion sections including the implications of the study need expansion.
- 6. Greater number of references are required to boost the rigor of the study.
